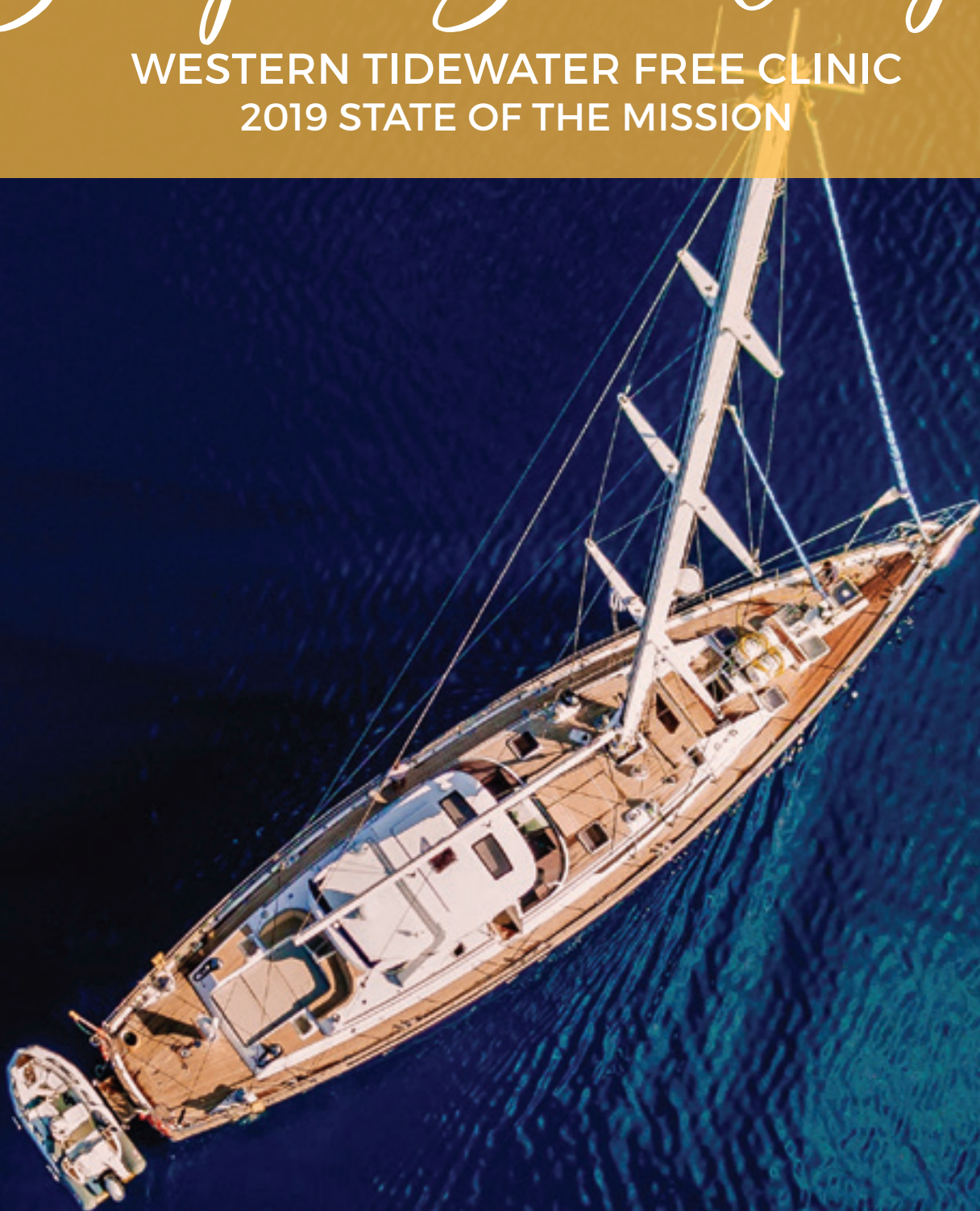

MISSION

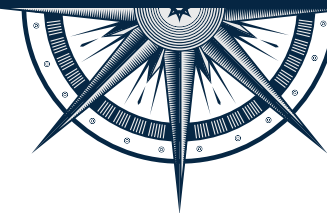
Our mission is to provide high-quality, non-emergency health care to the residents of Western Tidewater who cannot otherwise afford it.

This year found Western Tidewater Free Clinic (WTFC) in a sea of change and yet you have helped us remain steady. You saw us through many expansions in 2019 – increasing our service area to 2,200 square miles to include Surry and Sussex counties, expanding our income eligibility to include those living at 250% of the Federal Poverty Level, and broadening our clinic model and culture to a two-dimensional ‘hybrid’ clinic serving uninsured patients and current, underinsured WTFC patients included in the Virginia Medicaid expansion.

By following the beacon our mission has always provided us, Clinic leadership, staff, stakeholders, and community partners battened down the hatches and navigated the ocean of the unknown. And you, our donors, were the buoyant forces that kept us afloat. There were some storm-tossed seas along this journey but our ship is now stronger for it.

By the end of 2019, our staff and volunteers continued to provide a health home to new and returning patients. In addition, they were also able to assist in successful enrollment of Medicaid-eligible patients who were unable to navigate this process on their own.

WHAT IS YOUR WHY?

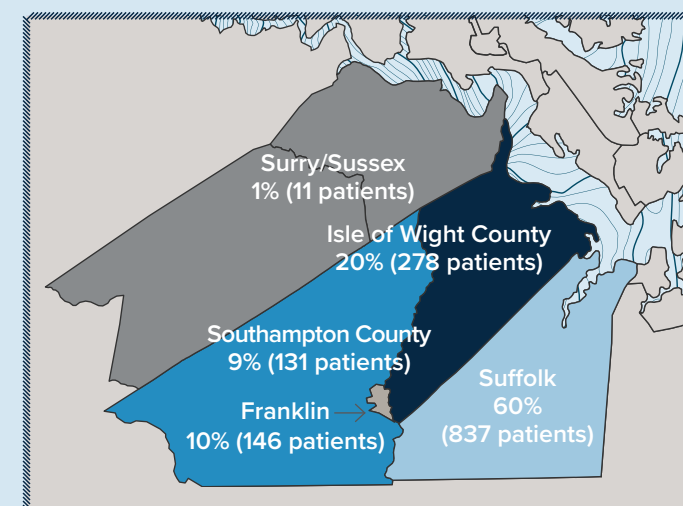
